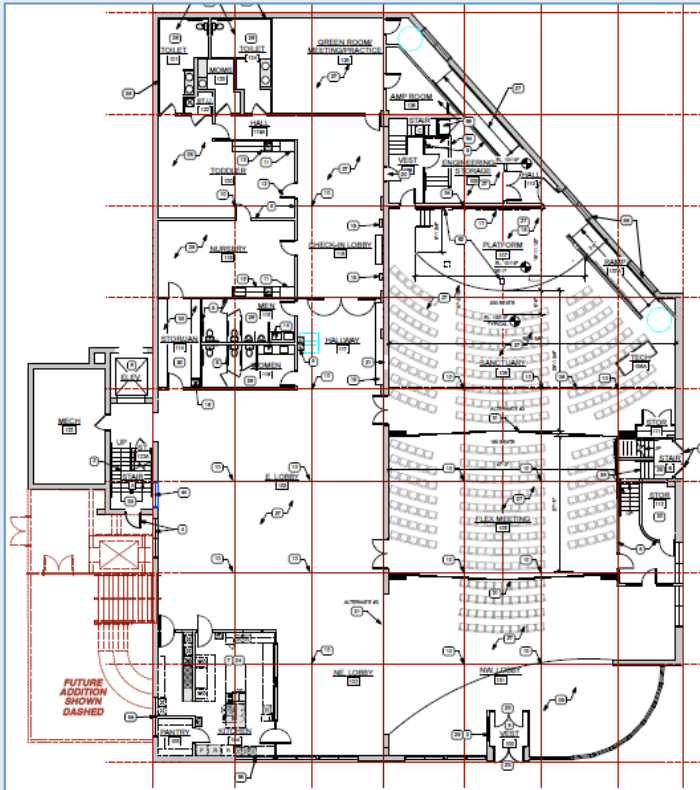


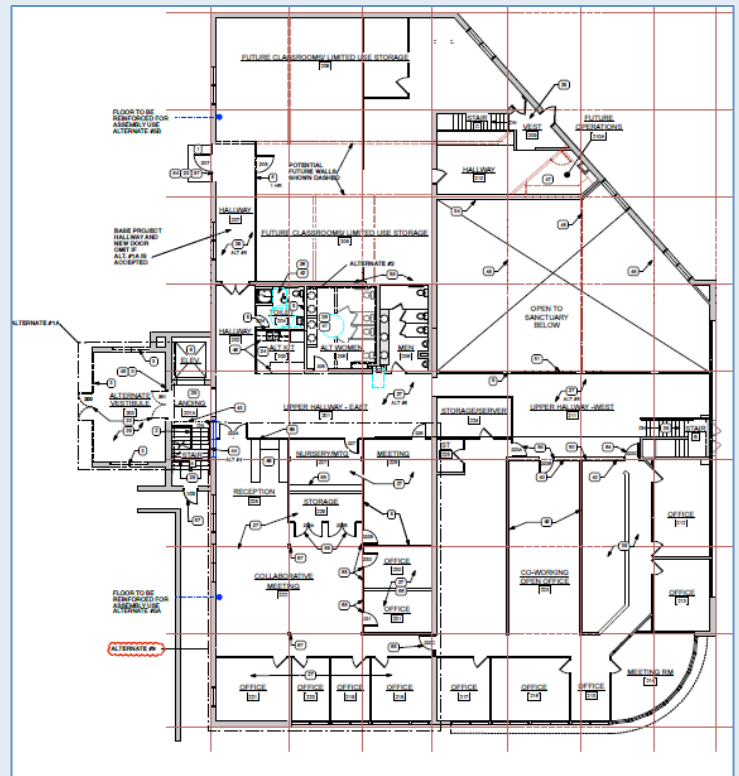
# Moving Forward: Towerside Church

“For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you a hope and a future.” Jeremiah 29:11

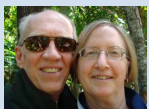


## Capital Campaign Kickstart!

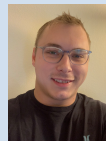
